BAYLAT: Bavarian Center for Latin America

Scholarships for students

Scholarships for students at Latin American Universities

- Funds Latin American students for a research stay at a partner institution in Bavaria
- Amount: 934 € per month + 200 € (one-off payment for health insurance)
- Funding period: 1 - 5 months
- Criteria: grades, quality and practicability of research stay, language skills level
- No funding for PhD candidates

Mobility scholarships for Bavarian students to Latin America

- Mobility grants for: study abroad for academic research, thesis writing (Bachelor's, Master's, or admission thesis), or internship stay in Latin America
- Amount: up to 1,500 €
- Last call is being evaluated

BAYLAT: Bavarian Center for Latin America

BAYLAT-Call for Proposals for New Scientific Projects (BAYLAT-Anschubfinanzierung)

- **Aim:** creating new and long-lasting scientific cooperation between Bavarian and Latin American partner institutions
- **Eligibility:**
 - collaborative projects of investigation
 - design of joint study programs
 - collaborative projects aiming at the improvement of lectureship
- Yearly call for proposals
- Funding of up to 8,000 € per proposal
- Also includes travel costs to Bavaria and accommodation for Latin American partners
- Open for all disciplines and themes and 20 countries in Latin America

BAYLAT: Bavarian Center for Latin America

FAPESP/BAYLAT-Workshop

- **Aim:** increase and expansion of cooperation in science and research between the partner regions Bavaria and the State of São Paulo including funding of junior researchers
- **Eligibility:** Scientific workshops, mobility of scientists, information exchange
- Yearly call for proposals
- Workshops take place in Bavaria and in the State of São Paulo
- Funding: approx. 25,000 EUR for each side
- Open for all disciplines and themes and researchers from the two regions
- Last call (2023) is being evaluated for funding years 2024-2026

International Network IraSME

- Network of ministries and funding agencies
- Synchronized national funding for transnational R&D projects
- National / regional funding conditions are binding

Two calls for proposals per year

- Deadlines end of March and September
- 34th call: June until 25th September 2024
- Documents: IraSME proposal application form + national application form

International Network IraSME

Project Requirements

- Development of new or significant improvement of existing products, processes and technical services
- Bottom-up approach
- Up to prototype level (TRL 4-7)
- Significant technical risks for each partner
- High market potential

Typical IraSME Project

- 2-6 participants – clearly distinct subprojects for each partner
- 2 SMEs / 2 participating countries / regions
- RTOs as additional partners or subcontractors (e.g. For EMBRAPPII Brazil!)

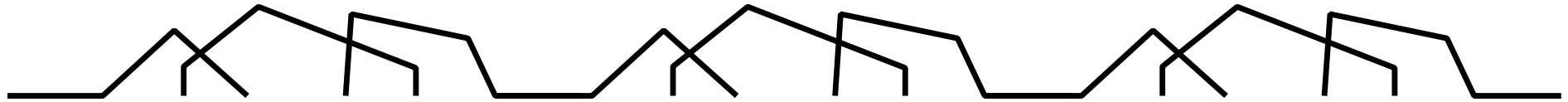
